The following art is made specifically for a "coffee house" environment. They are painted cardboard collage objects made from found materials. They are light weight and are easy to hang. I hope you like them.



















All of the peices are collaged ink drawings made on found cardboard then coated with clear medium and acrylic paints. The primary reason for this work is the to create a pleasant aesthetic experience for the casual coffe house visitor. They reflect the street life outside as seen from a contemplative view inside.
